# **Group Bookings**


Groups of 8 for a beginner course - Adults £65 per head, Juniors £45 per head. Please give the centre a call for further details.

# **Kidsgrove Ski Centre**

We have two 90 metre slopes, one for teaching and recreational use and the other for freestyle. On the freestyle slope we have permanently sited jumps and rails that are available for use whenever we are open.



Both slopes are covered with the very forgiving Playgrass surface that has a misting system. The slopes are floodlit.

There is a ski lodge with tea shop and a superb family atmosphere. During opening times the shop sells hot and cold drinks, sweets and chocolate bars. In addition there are hot oatcakes, bacon sandwiches/baps and sausage rolls during the morning and lunch time on Sundays.

# Ski / boarding levels required for Membership

**Recreational skiers** must ski in control and be capable of performing snowplough turns.

**Boarders** will need to demonstrate full turns - a 'falling leaf' is not sufficient.

All members must be able to control both their speed and direction. All skiers/boarders must complete a separate form to use the **Freestyle slope** 

#### Lessons

Our team of volunteer ski instructors is qualified and registered with Snowsport England.

For beginners we operate a programme of ski instruction aiming to take a person from never putting a pair of skis on their feet to a snowplough turning standard and the ability to use the ski tow, thus



enabling them to use the slope safely for recreational skiing. These courses must be booked in advance, please call for availability.

We also run intermediate lessons, these are 1.5-hour lessons aimed at eliminating bad habits and improving your technical skiing ability which will allow you to cope with more varied ski conditions. Again, these need to be booked in advance.

Please note that all lessons need to be booked and paid for in advance via the telephone (01782 784908) or in person at the ski centre when the club is open. Sorry, we are unable to give snowboarding lessons.

No lesson bookings can be taken on-line or via email.
